Spring * Break

Grow some creativity with these spring inspired crafts

What do coffee filters, clothes pins, rocks and feathers have in common? They can all be used to create crafts and keep little hands busy during Spring Break and beyond.

Keep craft supplies together in a container to make them easily accessible when the creative spirit moves your kids. In fact, decorating your craft supply box can be a creative expression in itself.

Here are some ideas to inspire crafting sessions.

Butterfly clips

With a wooden clothes pin as its body and a coffee filter for wings, it's easy to make this craft fly. Coffee filters are great for water colour paints.

Dampen the filter with water and watch the colours spread. Or for a more precise design, paint or colour a dry filter. Paint the clothes pin to match. Gather the filter in the middle and clip it in place with the clothes pin. Use a twist tie or chenille stem to make the antennae. Your butterfly can be clipped onto a curtain or an indoor plant. Apply a magnet to the bottom of the clothes pin and attach it to metal objects.

Put some paint on it

Small smooth stones are the perfect vehicle for paints and during the pandemic they have been used to convey simple messages of hope and good will. Get into the act and create some rock art of your own.

If painted rocks are to reside outside, seal them with a waterproof clear coat.



Put a flower in it

Clay pots provide another perfect canvas and they're also practical. Design a one-of-a-kind flower pot and plant a seed in it. Marigolds are easy to grow and are well suited to a small container. Plant seeds now and they will be well on their way by Mother's Day. Clay pots are porous and will need to be sealed with a waterproof clear coat for outdoor use.

Fun with feathers

Use craft feathers as paint brushes and then attach them to the art work. This technique is great for wall art, greeting cards or decorating paper lunch bags to be used for gift bags. Paper lunch bags are handy for so many things including crafts. It's simple to create hand puppets using the bottom as the head and the natural fold as the mouth. Make some "wild" birds and shoot a video of them "singing".
